

Off Licence

Issued under Sections 17 to 20, and 64 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012



Licence No: 73/OFF/7412/2023

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **Invercargill Licensing Trust** is authorised to sell alcohol, on the premises situated at **8 Windsor Street, Invercargill** and known as **WINDSOR STREET WINE STORE** to any person for consumption off the premises, and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

If this licence is not endorsed, under Section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the Licensee in accordance with Part 2 Subpart 7 of the Act.

Conditions:

- (a) Alcohol may only be sold or delivered on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Saturday 8.00 am to 11.00 pm
Sunday 9.00 am to 10.00 pm
- (b) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on ANZAC Day.
- (c) The whole of the premises is designated as a **supervised area**.
- (d) When alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises, potable drinking water must be freely available to customers at the same location.
- (e) The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence including the Host Responsibility Policy aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol.
- (f) The licensee must ensure the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

The Licensed Premises

The Premises located at 8 Windsor Street, Invercargill are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped and received by the Invercargill District Licensing Committee on 18 October 2023.

Display of Licence and Principal Entrance

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Windsor Street, Invercargill is designated as the principal entrance.

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, the licence expires on:

22 NOVEMBER 2026
